Sarah Julia, daughter of Albert and Sarah William, was born at Portia, Kansas, February 13, 1900, and departed this life at Denver, Colo., October 4, 1935, at the age of 35 years, 7 months and 21 days. Her girlhood life was spent in Osborne county. On April 30, 1922, she was united in marriage to Fred Gruning, and to this union four children were born Wanda Eileen 12, Lowell Lee 8, Phyllis Ann 7, and Robert Duane, 18 months

In the spring of 1927 the family moved to Monument, Kans., residing there about two years. In August, 1931, they moved to Deertrail, Colo., and from there they went to Otis, Colo., where she lived the remainder of her life. She was
